Kelly brought hers to a widow we know and have been witnessing to. She has been dealing with many issues since her husband died in January and was thrilled to have it. *"Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction . . ."* (James 1:27) May God bless our efforts.

At the end of April was an annual Men's Camp, put on by Bible Baptist Church in Ballincollig (second photo). This year's theme was about Lot and touched on many of the issues Christians are and will be facing today concerning sodomy. It was very timely and a wonderful time of fellowship with men from around the country, Irishmen as well as other preachers.
