Jeremy Snipes from Hyles-Anderson College graciously sacrificed a week of his life to teach a whirlwind of 45 hours of classes in one week! It will allow pastors and lay-men to be able to study and receive a degree while continuing to work in their own communities and churches. We hope to equip and encourage many to catch the vision of church planting and discipleship. Please pray with us about this huge task that we have undertaken.

The Lord has recently allowed our paths to cross a handful of pastors who are in need of encouragement and direction. We are working to hold a one-day workshop and bring these men together for encouragement, edification, and sharing a vision. Lord willing, this workshop will be held in April. Please pray with us as we seek to walk through the doors that God opens to us.

Our family is well. We have six birthdays out of seven within the first four months of the year! The children are all turning one year older and are such a blessing in our home and in our church. We enjoy sharing in the work to which God has called us as a family. God is so good!
