We count it a joy to be able to report to you about what has happened here in Guatemala. October 12-18, 2019, we were blessed by the coming of a youth pastor and his wife, Joshua and Rebekah Howard (my son-in-law and daughter), from the First Baptist Church of Streetsboro, Ohio. They gave a helping hand in the ministry during their stay here. We pray that God might heal Brother Howard of a serious foot condition, and we ask your prayers also for this servant of God.

MEDICAL: In late September, I became gravely ill with dengue fever, a tropical disease, and I was hospitalized for three days. I got it from a mosquito bite, but I am now recovering from it. I thank you for your prayers for our health.

SCHOOL MINISTRY: In recent prayer letters, I have asked you to pray for the Public School Ministry, which we were able to start here last year. I have personally withdrawn myself from that work for health reasons and have turned it over to an assistant.

Although we have not been able to start a Bible Club in the school, we have been able to start one in a church member's home here. That work is two months strong, with a steady attendance and possibility for growth. Please pray for this work to prosper.

SAN JOSE PINULA: We have been praying for a meeting place in the outlying village of Puerta Negra, San Jose Pinula. Please continue praying for this need.
