### English Camp in a Public School

Last year, Gigi, one of our faithful teen girls, asked my wife for her phone number to give it to her teacher. Her English teacher had enjoyed our English Christmas activity at their school and wanted us to come back to participate in their English Camp the next school year. Her teacher kept in contact with my wife during the year. Due to COVID-19, we were unsure if the camp could still happen. Thankfully, since the situation has greatly improved, on August 27, we had wonderful time at MaeKu Noi Elementary School. The teacher told my wife we could bring our own team of teachers, lessons, and activities. Many students from the Burmese migrant school where we used to work now attend this school, as well as some of our church children. It was so great to reunite with some of our old students. My wife, a teacher from our church, and I spent the day with about 60 students. We taught them a Bible story, a Sunday school song, and a grammar lesson. Before leaving, each of the students and the teachers received a booklet that told the Gospel story, starting from Genesis. One of the teachers announced to the students that they should let us know who would like to come to church and that we would pick them up. We are so thankful for God opening doors and giving us opportunities to plant seeds and build relationships.



### Bible Studies

About five years ago, I was privileged to lead a teen boy by the name of Wut to Christ. His spiritual growth was up and down for quite a while, but for about two months now, he has been coming over to our house for Bible study and discipleship every Friday and Saturday. I am enjoying seeing him understand more and more of his faith and seeing him put that faith into practice. He has a heart to serve God and reach his village for Christ. He has been leading the songs at church, and two weeks ago, he began to co-teach our teen Sunday school class with me. Please keep this young man in prayer. He is the only one in his family who has accepted Christ as his Saviour.



### Visitation and COVID-19 Outreach

Saturday is our usual day to go out into the communities to visit our church families and their neighbors. Often we had enough people going out so we could split up into a ladies' group and a men's group. During one visit, we came upon a Christian couple whose parents were not saved. They were so excited that we had come to visit and asked me to share the Gospel with their parents. We were able to see 10 people profess faith in Christ as their Saviour, and many seeds have been planted.



Many of the families we get to know don't have much, and due to COVID-19, life is even more difficult for them. Thanks to your generosity, we have been able to help some students with their school registration fees, school transportation fees, or purchasing their uniform. We have also helped with some medical expenses and given dry food and basic supplies to families in need.
