One Saturday morning while out soul winning in Texas, we knocked on a door like usual. A man came to the door speaking Spanish and apologizing for not knowing English. To his surprise, we started speaking to him in Spanish. He agreed to listen to the Gospel and soon trusted in Christ as his Saviour. Nicolas was a very broken man. His son had been murdered in front of his house just two months before, and then his wife left him. Please pray for him; he needs God's grace.

At the end of February, we traveled to San Antonio to give a report to one of the first churches that started supporting us. It was great to see many familiar faces and to see them still faithfully serving God. While we were there, we celebrated my birthday with a walk around the scenic areas of downtown San Antonio.

More churches have taken us on for support. We are now at 75% of our target support level. We praise the Lord for leading us to churches that want to help spread the Gospel in Ecuador. We have also been steadily raising funds for the purchase of an airplane. God is certainly blessing our time here!
