We want to thank the individuals and churches that are helping to sponsor teens to go to high school this coming year. We were able to help five students either begin their first year or continue their studies. Your generosity is making a difference. Thank you and please continue to pray.

Finally, our family is doing well, but we have had a few sicknesses recently. Please pray for our youngest daughter Isabella, who has been diagnosed with the bacterial infection *H. pylori*.
