

WELCOME, MISSIONARY VISITORS:

We are excited and honored to have you visit our missionary warehouse! We keep our doors locked, so please ring the doorbell when you arrive and proceed upstairs to shop unless instructed otherwise.

We are conveniently located next to I69 at 93rd Street and Corporation Drive. Our address is 9250 Corporation Dr, Indianapolis 46256.

If coming on I69/37, you will exit onto 96^{th} St West and stay in the extreme left lane to exit at the first available street, Corporation Drive. Drive south on Corporation Dr. to 93^{rd} St. and turn right (Grainger building is on Corner) Our building is the last building on the left on 93^{rd} St – across from Home Depot.

We have 15,000 square feet of well-organized new or near new items for you to select from absolutely free to help with your family's needs. Most missionaries take over two hours to shop. While we want you to take all your family needs, we ask that you not take items to distribute to your ministry. We have several families a week coming, and could not sustain the quality we want to offer if large amounts are taken to distribute.

Our regular workday is Monday and Wednesday mornings from 9-12. We do open the warehouse to accommodate you at any time convenient for you if you give at least a week notice. We keep the front door locked, so ring bell upon arrival and wait for worker to open the door.

We have electrical hookups for RVs to stay overnight in our parking lot if needed. We have both a 50 Amp and 30 Amp hookup. Please schedule in advance.

Please note we are on Eastern Standard Time, so if you are coming from states north of us, we are an hour ahead of them. The change takes place in Northern Indiana.

WIDOW'S JAR MINISTRIES WAREHOUSE GUIDELINES

ITEMS AVAILABLE ARE FOR ACTIVE OR RETIRED MISSIONARIES ONLY:

Items selected are to be for your <u>personal family's use</u>, not to distribute to the people in your ministry. WJM is here to help missionaries financially with items their family needs. No one accompanying them is to shop unless they are a missionary.

PLEASE COME AT THE AGREED TIME:

Our volunteers only work at the warehouse from 9-12 on Mondays and Wednesdays. We are happy to assist you on whatever day is convenient for you, but on other days we will be making a special trip to meet you, so please come at the time agreed.

YOUNG CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED

We try to keep everything that might harm young children on higher shelves, but we ask that you supervise your children at all times; and, if possible, bring someone with you assigned to do that while you shop. Most missionaries take about 2 hours to shop, and children can become restless. There is a playroom set up for young children. We ask that they not play with toys in separate area meant for distribution.

PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE WORKERS' AREA S:

Upstairs and down there are work and storage areas. Please do not enter these areas.

PLEASE FOLLOW OUR PROCEDURES FOR TAKING ITEMS:

You will be provided a cart on which to put your items. When the cart is full, it is to be brought to your assigned table where we will pack it in boxes. Please follow the directions they give you.

PLEASE TAKE AS LONG AS YOU LIKE TO "SHOP":

Our goal is to help you with some of your expenses by providing needs. We understand that many missionaries need to have children's clothing for several years ahead, so please feel free to take all that you personally need and will use.

<u>RENTER'S AREA</u>: We share our warehouse with our renters who provide food for the needy around the world. Please do not go into their warehouse area. Signs inform you where the boundaries are..

**<u>LIMITED ITEMS</u>: Certain items are limited as to how many you may take due to their high cost. This includes <u>power tools</u>, <u>sheets</u>, <u>suitcases & 220 electronics</u>. There are signs posted. Please do not take more than allowed.

WE REQUIRE 6 MONTHS BETWEEN VISITS

Please do not come if you are ill.
