Since our last letter, we have been very busy working in the two churches. **By the grace of God, more than 40 people have received Christ as their Saviour in recent months.**

**We celebrate our church anniversary, as usual, the entire month of November. This year we titled it, “O Lord, Revive Thy Work” (Habakkuk 3:2).** Every Sunday, we had a special activity. On the third Sunday of the program, we put emphasis on bringing to church the weak and the strays. Several of those who came to church walked the aisle during the invitation. I preached a message entitled, “Do Not Be Discouraged.” We saw several people saved, and many made decisions to consecrate their lives to the Lord during the anniversary. Glory to the Lord!
