**Pastor Kingsley Addai:** “I am so thankful to God for all that He is doing here in Mampondeng. I was walking by when I heard someone calling, ‘Pastor! Pastor!’ I stopped to see who was calling me, and it was a woman and her family. When I asked her why they wanted my attention, she said they wanted to come to our church, and she had told others to let me know. I was super excited! I showed them where our church meets, and they have been coming for three consecutive weeks. They have heard the Gospel and have trusted Christ alone for their salvation. Last week, the teenage boy followed the Lord in baptism, and the mother is planning to do so this coming Sunday. I’m asking for your prayers for this beautiful family.
