### Furlough Meetings

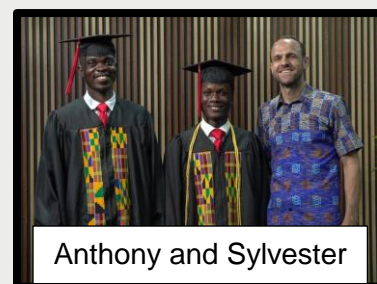
