The work continues! Here are more testimonies from several of our national pastors.

Pastor Otchere Boachie: "We praise God today! Adwoa (in white) brought her Muslim friend, Mamuna Shetu, to church. When Mamuna arrived at our church premises, she was hesitant to enter the auditorium because she was afraid of her Muslim parents.
