His wife had decided to send him home to his mother where he could die in peace the following day; however, the next day he woke up. I was out soul winning with one of our senior saints on one of our routes a few weeks ago. While I was witnessing to a young lady in her doorway, two men pulled up behind me on a motorcycle. I thought nothing of it, so I continued with the plan of salvation. Suddenly, I felt something to the back of my head. Once I realized it was a gun, I begrudgingly raised my hands. The man proceeded to rifle through my pockets, taking my house and church keys, my car keys, my cell phone, and my wallet. They did the same with my calling partner. Then they drove off.

Thankfully, we suffered no physical damage. I did notify my wife immediately about what had happened and told her to be careful since someone was on the loose with our house and church keys and to bring me the spare set of car keys. This is our newest route and has produced several families in our main church. We continue to work in that area and have many people in church every week from that route. We trust in the Lord and continue to request prayers for our safety.
