Thank you for your support and prayers. We were very excited on June 3 to hit our one-year mark since moving to El Salvador. We took the boys on a little vacation to an Airbnb with a pool. They loved being able to swim for seven hours.

This past year has been a new experience for all of us. God has provided for us in many ways through all of your sacrificial giving. We have been able to find a beautiful rental home. We also were able to purchase a 2015 11-passenger van. We have been able to use the van in many ways in the ministry. On Sundays, I've been able to pick up a bus route near the church, we use it for soul winning on Wednesday afternoons, and we have had a few friends fly in that we were able to pick up from the airport. This past year, there was a Bible Club that was started on Saturdays that has turned into a bus route.

We have also had a few bumps in the road. During our first month of moving here, my wife was alone with our two-month-old, and she accidentally locked herself out the house with our baby upstairs. Thankfully, with the Spanish she knows, she was able to get some help from the neighbors to get back in. We have had quite a few ER trips, minor but needed. We are learning as a family to live where God wants us and trusting He will continue to provide and protect. We are thankful to be where we are. This first year has been very good for

our family adapting to the country. We do not feel like we are going without. With El Salvador changing quickly, will you pray that we can do all we can to get the Gospel out? The new president is doing a great job at making things a bit more convenient and making it safe to live here. El Salvador was once known as the most dangerous country.

On the other hand, we have our tickets purchased to fly to North Carolina on July 14. My wife has an appointment on July 15 for a fetal echocardiogram. Pray that no delays happen with our flights and also for the appointment.

One of the most recent things we have done is start a discipleship program on Wednesday nights. We've already noticed the attendance growing for Wednesdays, and one of the teenagers in church received Christ as a part of it! Pray with us, as we look forward to starting new ministries and bus routes in the coming year!
