The altar was flooded with those making decisions, including those who surrendered to full-time Christian service. Several committed to attend Bible college this year. We celebrated the wedding of two of our college graduates, Elmer and Abigail, in May. They were the eighth couple from our graduates to marry. It was a beautiful ceremony,

celebrating another pair who dated correctly and kept themselves pure. I look forward to seeing how God uses them.

God blessed my soul winning these last two months with Miss Yashmien getting saved on a Thursday night, coming the next Sunday to IBC to be baptized, and going out with a soul winner the next Thursday. Another rainy Thursday evening, I was able to meet a group of bicyclists at a local park and led 15 of them to the Lord. During Saturday soul winning, I was able to meet Mr. Santos at his house, a police officer for 22 years, who gladly heard the Gospel and trusted Christ.
