We served in soul winning, canvassing, and hosting a Bible Club in a new community where they desire to start a new bus route. We had a great time of games, songs, and the Gospel message. On the first day of the bus route, 15 attended church! At the end of the Bible Club, a group of young men arrived late. We quickly took them to the side, and after some games, I had the opportunity to share the Gospel with them. All 10 of them made a public profession for Christ. One of the young men, Jonathan, was the soccer coach. We are praying for the Lord to use him in that community.



Another sweet opportunity we had was to participate in an outdoor service at a home for young ladies, along with the church family. This is such a need all over Latin America. Many of the young ladies come from broken homes and have suffered from abandonment. The director stated that we were the first church to approach them and endeavor to be a blessing to their organization. Over 30 young ladies accepted Christ as their Saviour!



We ended the week with another Bible Club in one of the communities where the church has been working for some time now. I had the joy of sharing a lesson on eternal security and saw a few visitors saved. We praise the Lord that we were able to preach the Gospel to almost 250 souls and see over 100 make a profession of faith! Nothing compares to serving Jesus.
