


## Daniel & Erin LANG Your Missionaries to Nigeria

The work that God has called every believer to do is a great work! It's not an easy, convenient, or comfortable work. It is a rewarding, worthwhile, and important work. We are privileged to labor in these fields that are white unto harvest! I pray that you are obeying God's commands and are busy about the Father's business in the fields that He has called you to!

In August and September, I had the opportunity to preach and teach in 3 of the local area churches. I always enjoy getting to visit and fellowship with these churches and see how God is working in their midst. Despite the many challenges that these churches were facing, I was encouraged to hear how they were growing amid their struggles and to hear how God has continued to reward their efforts with spiritual fruit. In one of these churches, I had the opportunity to fellowship with around 10 pastors and some of their members. It was my great privilege to share how the Bible teaches that a church is supposed to care for their pastor and remind the pastors of their duties as well. Please pray that believers here in Nigeria would learn to rely on God alone as their source as they continue to seek to please Him.

At the end of September, we had our "Bible Club Sunday." Our Bible college students and church members run around 30 Bible

Clubs weekly in areas around the church. We invited the parents of the Bible Club children to come to church. On that day, we had an attendance of 814 people, with some of them being first-time visitors. The Gospel was clearly presented in both Sunday school and the morning service. We give God the glory for the wonderful turnout and look forward to seeing the fruit that will come from it. Please pray, as we have an "Outreach Sunday" planned for November 23, where we will hold church services in around 20 different areas where our church members are located. Also, for the remainder of the year, we are teaching and preaching about financial giving during the services. Please pray that our people would understand the need to give and see how God will bless them when they do.

In October, we greatly enjoyed having my brother Ben, who is also our sending-church pastor, visit for a few days. The kids were thrilled to have their uncle around! He had the opportunity to preach at one of our local churches as they dedicated their new building to the Lord. He also had the opportunity to visit some of our church members and preach for two nights during an outreach program at our City of Refuge. We are always grateful when someone makes the sacrifice, both of their time and resources, to come and see what God is doing here!
