We had the opportunity to go out this month to a public event for Taiwan's national birthday, which commemorates the Wuchang uprising that led to the formation of the current government in Taiwan. We were invited by our friend C\_\_\_. We went to a local park where hundreds had come to form a citizens' parade. Our kids drew a lot of attention as we walked a couple of miles with the crowd. We met a lot of people and were able to pass out tracts.
