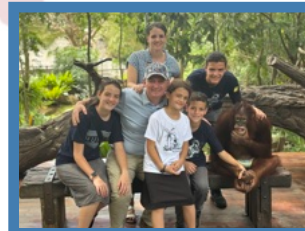
The Missions Mastermind was such a blessing. It gave us the opportunity to spend time with great missionaries and learn from those who have years of experience. I am thankful for both Pastor

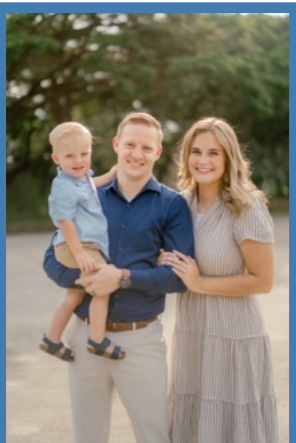
