In the middle of October, we had the opportunity to attend a Missions Conference in Northern Mexico at Iglesia Bautista El Camino in Tijuana, Mexico, after which Karen and I were able to attend our church's Marriage Retreat.

This month of November has been busy as well. The church where we are currently working is preparing to celebrate their 22<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary. There have been several work days, with the men of the church making needed repairs and updates to the church property. Lord willing, we will see lives reached during the Anniversary Conference. Please be in prayer for this meeting.

Praise the Lord, a few of our prayer requests previously mentioned have been answered and/or are in the process of being answered. I have an appointment scheduled later this month for my Mexican Residency, and Karen has been given a date for her U.S. Citizenship Exam. We will be returning to the USA briefly in the month of December to attend that appointment.
