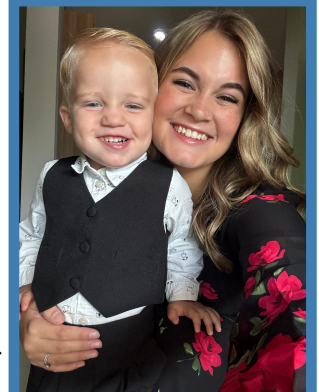
There is a man who has been coming to our church for many years. His wife Wanprapa has been a Buddhist her entire life and would not come to church with him. I visited them the first month we were here and tried to share the Gospel with her, but she was completely uninterested and did not want to discuss spiritual things. Katie Belle and I continued to visit them and tried to build a relationship with her. One Sunday, Wanprapa came to church with her husband! We were thrilled. She came the next Sunday too and the Sunday after that. In fact, she has not missed a Sunday yet! She came to me multiple times with questions about

things I had said in my sermons. Just a couple of weeks ago, she raised her hand during the invitation. I sat down with her after the service and walked her through the Romans Road. At each point, she simply said, "I believe that." So, I took her to Romans 10:9-10 and showed her that belief comes from the heart and confession is made with the mouth. She then, very sweetly, bowed her head and asked Jesus to save her! We have a powerful God Who can soften any heart.

One afternoon, I received a message that someone had reached out to the church and asked for a pastor to visit their dying friend. When I arrived at the house, Roger, a 91-year-old British man, was lying on a roller bed next to the back door. He was so weak he could not speak but was completely conscious. I asked him if he knew he was going to Heaven. He shook his head. I asked him if I could show him how to know. He nodded. I led him through the Gospel and asked if he wanted to receive Christ. He reached for my hand and squeezed it gently. I led him in the sinner's prayer, and when I asked him if he had believed, he nodded again. Moments after we finished praying, an ambulance arrived to take him to the hospital. Apparently, his friend had waited to call the ambulance until we had spoken with him. That's why he was by the back door. Roger passed away just a few days ago. Thank God for Heaven!
