I had mentioned one of our church men, Diego Hernandez, in a previous letter. Diego is a Bible college graduate and plans to start a church. However, he was plaqued with reflux problems and went for reflux surgery here in our city. Sadly, there were

complications during the procedure, and Diego went into respiratory arrest during the surgery. Because of the lack of oxygen, he came out of the operating room in a comatose state with a brain injury.

Our church was fervently praying for him, as well as many friend churches. The doctors gave us no hope, but God heard our prayers. After 13 days, Diego woke up. He is slowly progressing and needs assistance. He is also suffering from severe amnesia, but he is with us! Diego's family now wants to start a new van route in our church. Please pray for his continued recuperation.

We just finished our grand 2025 Missions Conference. Our members were challenged, inspired, and blessed. On Saturday, we had a special time of "Soul Winning with the Missionaries." We had 30 people saved, and 3 first-time visitors came the next day as a result. Praise God for the world vision He is instilling in our people!

In our last letter, I mentioned we had the light meter put in for our second church. One of our men installed some provisional lights until we can design a full lighting plan. My wife and I both run routes for this church, and the Lord has been blessing there with faithful people.

We were so pleased to have a supporting pastor come down to visit us! It's a rare treat for someone to come down this side of the border to see us. We shared tacos, fellowship, and visits with our members. His presence reminded us of how vital it is for supporters to see firsthand the lives being touched here. I would like to extend an open invitation to come see the work the Lord has done here through His humble servants.

Please continue to pray for God's guidance as I lead the people He has placed under my care. Pray also for some health concerns the doctors have discovered that we must monitor. Pray for God's continued blessings upon our ministry. We are praying for you.
