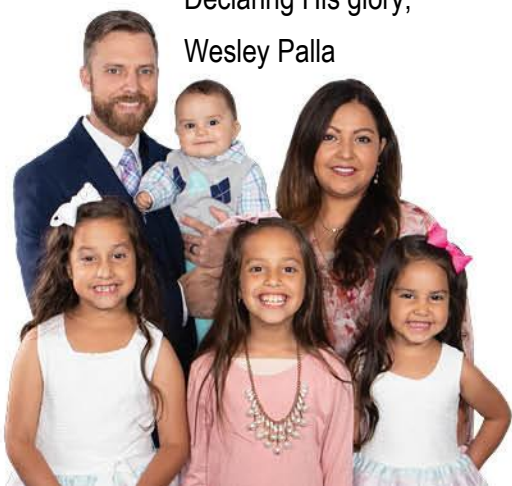

I will admit, I am very concerned about what it is going to cost us to fully finish the necessary construction, but when worry starts to grow, I remind myself how God has blessed us so abundantly already throughout this process of growth and expansion. He has taken care of everything so far; we believe He will continue to supply for each need as it comes up. Please keep the construction as a matter of prayer. On top of the major construction phase we find ourselves in, we will also begin our second semester of Bible institute in February, we will take two more missions trips to other parts of the northeast of Brazil, and we have added two more conferences to our annual church calendar (Family and Youth). Our desire is to see more souls saved, more churches planted, more laborers trained to serve in the Lord's harvest, and our church able to move into our permanent property before year's end. For all of this, we covet your prayers.
